St. John's past is worth preserving

St. John's has been proclaiming the Good News of Jesus Christ in Center City for more than 187 years!

- Survived the Civil War, two World Wars, two fires, and the anti-Catholic riots of 1844.
- Fed over 700 starving people daily during the Great Depression.
- Founded St. John's Hospice for outreach to poor & homeless.
- Founded Holy Redeemer Catholic Church as missionary outreach to the Chinese community.
- Hosted two saints: St. John Neumann & St. Katherine Drexel.



St. John's present is worth preserving

Today we welcome people of all races, political ideologies, and socioeconomic classes.

- Since 1991, Saint John's has been staffed by Capuchin Franciscan Friars. Saint John's has a Franciscan identity of simplicity, prayer and inclusion of poor and marginalized persons. Saint John's also hosts a dynamic SecularFranciscan fraternity of lay Franciscan's who base their lives on following Jesus after the example of Saint Francis.
- Offer 4 masses and 44 liturgies every Ash Wednesday.
- Host 80 weddings a year!
- Provides 150 end-of-life urgent visits and 1,000 anointings of the sick.
- Offers 3 masses a day, provides confession 4 times a week and adoration 6 days a week.
- · Opens its doors to visitors, tourists, residents, and workers alike!

We need your help.

St. John's is a beautiful Church, old and often needing repairs, but well-maintained.

We face a three-fold crisis that threatens St. John's survival into the future.





¹ COURTYARD REPLACEMENT

Behind the church and friary, there is a courtyard that serves as a small, square concrete cover for the major mechanical systems of the church.

It is deteriorating, deemed unsafe for use, and needs to be replaced

imminently.







The electrical system powering both the upper and lower churches is very old, from the 1960's.

It could fail at any time. It needs to be replaced imminently.





3AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEM REPLACEMENT

The air conditioning system powering the upper church is very old, past it's predicted useful life.

It is expected to fail at any time. It needs to be replaced imminently.





TOTAL COST ESTIMATE: \$1,255,000

Cost breakdown:

- 1. Courtyard replacement \$400,000
- 2. Electrical system replacement \$230,000
- 3. Air conditioning system replacement \$500,000
- 4. Architect, engineering, and construction \$125,000

Estimated total cost: \$1,255,000

Funds received or expected:

- 1. Cash on hand \$125,000
- Contribution from Historic Preservation Fund - \$100,000
- 3. Expected proceeds from an estate bequest \$200,000
- 4. "Soft" pledges \$225,000

Estimated funds expected: \$650,000

Amount needed from the Capital Campaign: \$400,000


